Our Civil War (1865)
Charlotte Beauregard celebrates the contributions of Abraham Lincoln, Harriet Tubman, and Ulysses S. Grant while exploring the key battles at Fort Sumter, Appomattox, and Gettysburg.



The Industrial Revolution Gilded Age (1891)
Settlement house owner Eloise Remington contrasts the robber barons' opulent lifestyles with the tragedy of the Johnstown flood and the bleak practices of child labor and the orphan train movement.



One-Room Schoolhouse (1890s)
Enroll in Miss Mabel's one-room school for a taste of nineteenth-century education. You won't need your primers or a clean slate to delight in the square dance at the spring jubilee.



Grace the Pirate
